Trump's approval ratingeflects the divided nature of the North Carolina electorate 9% approve of the job he is doing as President an 55 disapprove. Among approvers, 33% strongly approve and 6% somewhat approve of Trump's president as President. Among disapprovers, only 5 somewhat disapprove, while 5 strongly disapprove of the job he is doing as President.

Among Democrats, 49% disapprove of President Trump's job performance, includ 29% who strongly disapprove. Amonig dependents, 58% disapprove of his job performance, including 39% who strongly disapprove. Among Republicar%, 49% sapprove of his job performance, including 4% who strongly disapprove. Contrast this with Trump's oval numbers. Among Republicans, 46% strongly approve while 22% somewhat approve.
