Biden leads Trump by 10 nationally

Former Vice President Joe Biden has a 10-point lead over President Donald Trump in the contest for the White House in a new poll of likely voters released by the UMass Lowell Center for Public Opinion. Biden's double-digit lead signals that the President's hopes of reelection are dwindling, with less than three weeks until election day and many voters already voting early and by mail.

With minor party candidates included on the ballot, Biden polls at 35%, Trump at 24%, other candidates at 2%, and only 3% of likely voters say they are still undecided.

The relatively low number of undecided voters is underscored by the fact that 16% of voters have already voted. Just over two-thirds of voters plan to eschew the traditional Election Day polling place in 2020 and either vote by mail (45%) or vote early in person (22%).

Biden leads among voters with a college degree 62% to Trump's 36%. Among those with no bachelor's degree, Biden leads 49% to Trump's 34%. However, among white respondents without
